

Cisco Pie Fest Pie Eating Contest

Does your team have what it takes? Your team will consist of three pie eating people. There is a \$20 fee per team, for the Cisco Pie Fest Pie Eating Contest, fee will go to help cover costs. Teams will bring lots and lots of enthusiasm (props, costumes, signs, are all encouraged, bring your pie appetite, as each team member tries to eat as much of their apple pie, as fast as they can, without using their hands or utensils.

Rules & Regulations

- 1) Contestant must be 16 years or older – Entry form must be signed by parent or guardian if under 18.
- 2) Groups must be registered by 5:00pm on June 6th, 2019. All teams must assemble at the Pavilion by 11:15 the day of the contest, Saturday June 15th.
- 3) Each team member, must sign a waiver, in person, before the competition or will not be allowed to compete.
- 4) Time: 11:30am Saturday, June 15th, 2019
- 5) Location: Pavilion by the Conrad Hilton Center
- 6) The goal of the team is for each team member to eat as much of their pie, with water as the only beverage, within that team members 4-minute time period. After 4 minutes a whistle will be blown to signal the next team members 4-minute period. When the third and final team player is eating, the whistle will blow a final time signaling the last person to stop eating. Each team member will have their own pie. (Water will be provided during contest).
- 7) Contestants will wait for the whistle to blow before starting, contestants must not touch pie until the whistle blows to begin – Contest will be timed with a stopwatch.
- 8) Any pie in contestant's mouth at the final whistle is counted - provided it is then swallowed.
- 9) The use of hands or utensils are not permitted. Only your face and mouth. Hold your hands behind your back. Pie must be consumed. It may not be spit out. Contestants can use their hands to drink water during the contest but must return them behind their back while eating the pie.
- 10) The team that can eat the most pie within the 12 minutes time period (4 minutes per each team member), is the winner. At the end of the 12 minutes, each pie plate will be weighed and the team who has eaten the most pie wins.
- 11) In the event of a tie -whichever one of the tied contestants who, in the opinion of the judges, ends up wearing the most pie and the biggest pie smile, will be declared the overall winner.
- 12) The judges will determine the winner of the contest, not the participants. The judges' decision will be final.
- 13) Prizes:

Team with the most spirit, the prize will be one trophy per team & certificates given for each team member with the most team spirit.

Team that eats the most pie, the prize will be one engraved belt buckle for the team & a T-Shirt for each team member eating the most pie.

(*The team trophy and team belt buckle will be kept for one year by the winning team, until next year's festival, they will then be passed on to that next year's winners.***)**

Any Contestant caught breaking any of the following rules and regulations, will be disqualified.

A contestant may not leave the table during the contest. Any visible signs of sickness, starting before the start signal is given, putting hands in mouth or into pie filling or pushing food on floor, as well as any of the above listed rules, will be grounds for disqualification from the contest.
